Thank you for your most recent request for information regarding Mr Rahul Jain, Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeon, with regard to provision of medicolegal reports.

Mr Jain's Terms and conditions of business:

1. Mr Jain aims to see clients within four to six weeks of receipt of medical records/instructions. Clients will be seen in a special clinic at the enclosed locations.
2. Clients are sent an appointment letter and medicolegal questionnaire prior to their appointment. The questionnaire is designed to collect their thoughts about events that may have occurred a long time ago. The questionnaire can be photocopied by the client prior to being seen. If not done, after the consultation it will not be shared.
3. Clinics are held throughout the week, weekends and some evenings. Most venues rotate on a 4–6-week basis.
4. Mr Jain aims to have the completed report sent off to the commissioning agent within ten working days.
5. Mr Jain prefers all GP and Hospital records to be gathered by the commissioning agent, and it is preferable to have these sent with the original letter of request. These are acceptable via email or an online portal. Mr Jain does not accept paper records. Radiology review must be accompanied with the Radiologist's report.
6. All bookings to be made through my secretary via the above email address.

I have undertaken medicolegal work since 2001 and have attended numerous medicolegal courses to keep myself up-to-date. My Medco accreditation has also been renewed. I have been preparing medico-legal reports since 2001 and currently perform 300 - 400 reports per year.

I am instructed for 30-50 medical negligence cases per year and was last in Court (successfully) in October 2020.

Report ration is 80% for plaintiff, 10% joint instructions, 10% for defendant. I have also attended seminars relating to medico-legal reporting in Warwick and London.

I undertake any form of personal injury work, and I am happy to undertake domiciliary/prison visits.

I aim to see patients within 4-6 weeks and have the completed report returned within 7 to 10 working days, on average – documentation permitting.

I am happy to provide an online booking service and can return reports electronically if acceptable.

I am also happy to undertake clinical negligence and complex specialist injury/orthopaedic cases

I am happy to see patients with general trauma and orthopaedic conditions, including back pain, whiplash, arthritis, post fracture of bones/soft tissue injuries, or complications of such injuries.
